

F. Office of Intergovernmental Programs and Outreach

Mission

The mission of the Office of Intergovernmental Programs and Outreach (IPO) is to provide project management and outreach for the EERE deployment programs and provide technical assistance, training and program development assistance in partnership with customers and stakeholders. The project areas include the State Energy Program, the Weatherization Assistance Program, the Federal Energy Management Program, renewable energy programs, and the biomass and industrial technology programs. The programs are implemented mainly through financial assistance awards.

Required Services

The Contractor shall provide support services to the Office of Intergovernmental Programs and Outreach in the following areas:

1.0 Administrative Support

- 1.1 Maintain time and attendance records for employees within the Office of Intergovernmental Programs and Outreach;
- 1.2 Prepare, consolidate, proof read and/or finalize letters/correspondence;
- 1.3 Arrange/coordinate/schedule meetings;
- 1.4 Maintain division calendar;
- 1.5 Answer phone, take messages, and transfer calls;
- 1.6 Coordinate conference calls;
- 1.7 Prepare files and print business cards;
- 1.8 Complete/maintain forms;
- 1.9 Copy and fax documents as necessary;
- 1.10 Attend recurring meetings and prepare meeting notes as necessary.
- 1.11 Perform back-up for WinSAGA when needed.

2.0 Project Management/WinSAGA Support

- 2.1 Provide both financial and project data management support to Project Managers, States and other grantees;

- 2.2 Develop and maintain data spreadsheets of grant status.
- 2.3 Prepare quarterly indicator reports of grant status by grant numbers and programs.
- 2.4 Review reports submitted by recipients and compile data for use by Project Officers;
- 2.5 Create PRs, post documents on the PMC website, enter data in to WinSAGA for states that do not enter data, and manage state reporting data in WinSAGA.

3.0 Weatherization Assistance Program

- 3.1 Develop and maintain program datasheets/database tracking on production and budget projections;
- 3.2 Prepare and submit status reports and updates, including recommendations for DOE action to Project Managers for specific projects;
- 3.3 Provide support to the IPO and states in planning and carrying out state/regional or national weatherization meetings, training and peer exchange;
- 3.4 Assist in the conduct of monitoring visits, writing reports and recommendations on the results of the monitoring.

4.0 Air Quality/Green Power

- 4.1 Support the execution of the EERE/Air Quality State Pilot initiatives;
- 4.2 Support the design and implementation of multi-state web casts for a primarily state audience on EERE/Air Quality integration;
- 4.3 Support the design and implementation of EERE/Air Quality integrated state training;
- 4.4 Provide support for the 2006 National Air Innovations Conference held in Denver in Sept. 2006;
- 4.5 Support the development and implementation of leveraging opportunities for EERE/Air Quality and other program areas, as needed;
- 4.6 Support the joint agency work (DOE and EPA) on the Green Power Leadership Awards for 2007 and oversee the awards process.
