



## NOTICE OF AVAILABILITY

The U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) has issued a Finding of No Significant Impact (FONSI) based on completion of an Environmental Assessment (EA) that analyzes the potential environmental impacts associated with the:

**Wellford Landfill Methane and Greenhouse Gas to Energy Project**

**DOE/EA 1762**

**Spartanburg County, South Carolina**

Spartanburg County is proposing to install a system to capture methane from the Wellford Landfill and use it to generate electricity for local industries with (Congressionally directed) Federal funding from DOE. DOE's Golden Field Office has determined that providing cost-shared funding under the *American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009* to Spartanburg County for the proposed project would not constitute a major Federal action significantly affecting the quality of the human environment within the meaning of the *National Environmental Policy Act*.
