



## NOTICE OF AVAILABILITY

The U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) has issued a Finding of No Significant Impact (FONSI) based on the adoption of a Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (FERC) Environmental Assessment (EA) that described and evaluated the potential environmental impacts associated with the:

**Ocean Power Technologies, Inc. (OPT)  
Reedsport PB150 Deployment and Ocean Test Project  
Oregon Territorial Sea, off Reedsport, Oregon (DOE/EA 1890)**

DOE's Golden Field Office has determined that providing Federal financial assistance to support the deployment and testing for one of OPT's single, full-scale 150kW PB150 PowerBuoys off the coast of Reedsport, Oregon, would not constitute a major Federal action significantly affecting the quality of the human environment within the meaning of the *National Environmental Policy Act* (NEPA). Therefore the preparation of an environmental impact statement is not required and DOE hereby Adopts FERC's Environmental Assessment for Hydropower License (FERC Project No. 12713-002) for the Reedsport OPT Wave Park Project.
