Description:

B&E Actions to conserve energy, demonstrate substantial energy conservation, and promote energy efficiency that do not increase the indoor concentrations of potentially harmful substances. These actions may involve financial and technical assistance to individuals (such as building owners, consultants, designers, organizations) such as financial, and state and local government. Covered actions include, but are not limited to, programmed lighting of buildings, placement of timers on hot water heaters, installation of solar hot water systems, installation of efficient lighting improvements in general efficiency and appliance efficiency, development of energy-efficient manufacturing or industrial practices, and energy-conservation and renewable energy research and development at pilot projects. The actions could involve building retrofits to new structures to commercial, residential, agricultural, or industrial sectors. These actions do not include alternative energy sources, or proposed CXE legislation.

Rational for determination:

The State of California would pass through SEP funding to the City of Yucca for the installation of a 250 kW PV Carport Canopy System.

This system would be located at the City of Yucca Community Park, 24900 Oak Glen Road. The system would provide solar energy to the Community Center and one other city building. The project 25,000 sq. ft. Photovoltaic Carport Canopy System would cover 181 parking spaces. The existing parking lot. Construction would be via steel columns and concrete base with rock veneer, steel beam support columns and steel post framework, and concrete footings (approximately 36" dia. x 12" deep).

There will be no site improvement, other than parking and replacement of asphalt paving as necessary.

The activity complies in action to conserve energy, therefore it is CX-d under B&E.
