Based on my review of the information concerning the proposed action, as NEPA Compliance Officer (authorized under DOE Order 451.1A), I have made the following determination:

CX, EA, EIS APPENDIX AND NUMBER:

Description:

C12 Siting, construction, and operation of energy system prototypes including, but not limited to, wind resource, hydropower, geothermal, fossil fuel, biomass, and solar energy pilot projects.

Rational for determination:

The Michigan Department of Corrections proposes to provide Recovery Act funds to the Brooks Correctional Facility for the purchase and installation of a 1 MW wind turbine. The turbine would be constructed and operated at the Brooks facility located at 2500 Sheridan Road, Muskegon, MI.

Given the scope and complexity of the project, existing and potential impacts are unknown at this time. Per the DOE NEPA implementing regulations (Appendix C to Subpart D to 10 CFR Part 1021 - C12, as noted above), preparation of an Environmental Assessment is required prior to allowing federal funds for this proposed project.

NEPA PROVISION

DOE has made a conditional NEPA determination for this award, and funding for certain tasks under this award is contingent upon the final NEPA determination.

Insert the following language in the award:

You are restricted from taking any action using federal funds, which would have an adverse affect on the environment or limit the choice of reasonable alternatives prior to DOE/NNSA providing either a NEPA clearance or a final NEPA decision regarding the project.

Prohibited actions include:

DOE funds are not authorized for project site preparation, construction, and installation activities pending outcome of the environmental assessment.

This restriction does not preclude you from:

Michigan's Energy Office is authorized to initiate the preparation of an EA by a third-party contractor, consistent with DOE NEPA implementing regulations. DOE, Michigan's Energy Office and third-party contractor shall enter into a Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) defining the scope of services to be completed by the third-party contractor on behalf of DOE.

If you move forward with activities that are not authorized for federal funding by the DOE Contracting Officer in advance of the final NEPA decision, you are doing so at risk of not receiving federal funding and such costs may not be recognized as allowable cost share.

Insert the following language in the award:

You are required to:


Prepare an Environmental Assessment (EA) according to the format and protocol prescribed by the Department of Energy. The EA is to be forwarded to the Golden Field Office for review and final determination.
